NJHA's Pressure Injury Prevention Learning and Action Collaborative

This month, NJHA kick-started its activities for the Pressure Injury Learning Action Collaborative. Launched in May 2017, the Collaborative engages hospitals with an up-to-date webinar series, focusing on pressure injury research, interventions and best practices, followed by a conference. Faculty expert Mary Brennan, assistant director and clinical nurse specialist at North Shore University Hospital, led the Collaborative, which continues its efforts this year by focusing on sharing prevention strategies.

A multi-part webinar series will highlight specific techniques of prevention in the fields of nutrition, management and more. Presented by experts in these

areas, the Collaborative is engaging N.J. healthcare facilities and addressing their HAPU and PSI rates of measure. Best practices and strategies will be shared across hospitals through coaching calls.
