CCS EXAM PREPARATION CODING WORKSHOP.....3/20/08 and 3/27/08
This workshop is designed for the experienced coder who is ready to sit for the CCS examination. This workshop will offer review of test taking, ICD-9-CM coding, CPT coding, and other issues relevant to the exam. CPT Review will be offered on March 20 followed by ICD-9 Review on March 27. Participants may register for the two day course or for just a one day refresher on either ICD-9-CM or CPT coding.

CPT CODING I (BIOPSY-GI SCOPES-URINARY SCOPES PROCEDURES)4/17/08
This workshop is taking a body system approach to CPT coding. Geared toward coders who would like to improve their skills, this focused workshop will offer instruction along with practice exercises and actual cases. *CPT Coding I* will cover coding rules and guidelines and biopsy coding, GI topics such as scopes, EUS, ablation, snare, hot biopsy, capsule, screening, dilations and more. Additional topics will include urology guidelines, anatomy, cystoscopy, ureteroscopy, and stents. We will also cover coding from endoscopy reports

CPT CODING II (SKIN AND BREAST PROCEDURES) 6/5/08
This workshop is taking a body system approach to CPT coding covering skin excisions, repairs, flaps, grafts and breast procedures. We will cover coding from operative report. *CPT Coding II* is designed for coders interested in improving their skills with instruction, practice exercises and cases.

CPT CODING III (MUSCULOSKELETAL).....9/18/08
CPT Coding III will offer instruction and practice exercises relating to orthopedic coding of bunions, hammer toe, arthroscopic knee and shoulder procedures. This focused workshop is taking a body system approach for CPT coding and is geared for coders who would like to improve their skills.

TOPICS IN ICD-9-CM10/9/08
This workshop will cover ICD-9-CM coding's difficult topics. This workshop will be geared for coders who would like to improve their skills with instruction and practice exercises and cases. The topics will include cardiovascular, heart failure, sepsis, diabetes, ulcers and debridement, respiratory, renal disease, and the query process.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NEW JERSEY HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION

760 Alexander Road ■ Princeton, NJ ■ (609) 275-4000

From New York City and Northeastern New Jersey: NJ Turnpike to Exit 8A. After toll follow sign to "Cranbury-South Brunswick." Use jughandle after 1st light to turn left onto 535. Go to 2nd light. Turn right onto 614 West (Dey Road). Continue several miles to the 3rd light. Turn right onto Scudders Mill Road. Follow signs and get onto Route 1 South. Continue to Alexander Road East/Princeton Junction exit. Take exit and turn right onto Alexander Road (Hyatt Regency Princeton is on your right). Go through 3 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

From the Somerville area: Route 206 South to Nassau Street (Rt. 27-Princeton). Turn left. Turn right at 1st traffic light onto University Place. At light turn left onto Alexander Road. Continue across Route 1. Go through 3 lights. The New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

From Northwestern New Jersey: Route 31 South to Route I-95 North. I-95 North becomes Route I-295 South. Continue to Exit 67A (New Brunswick) for U.S. Route 1 North, keeping left. After 3rd traffic light, take exit for Alexander Road. At top of ramp, at light, make right onto Alexander Road. Go through 2 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

From Hightstown: Route 571 West (approximately 6 miles). Turn left at traffic light between Exxon and Shell stations onto Alexander Road. Bear left. Take first right (Alexander Road) to cross over railroad tracks. Continue approximately 2 miles to New Jersey Hospital Association on left.

From New Brunswick area: U.S. Route 1 South (approximately 15 miles) to Alexander Road East/Princeton Junction exit. Take exit and turn right onto Alexander Road (Hyatt Regency Princeton is on your right). Go through 3 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

From Philadelphia area: I-95 North from Philadelphia, continue across the Delaware River into New Jersey. Continue to Exit 67A (New Brunswick) for Route 1 North. After 3rd traffic light take exit for Alexander Road.

* At top of exit ramp, at light, make right onto Alexander Road. Go through 2 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

From Southern NJ: Route I-295 North to Exit 67A (New Brunswick) for Route 1 North. After 3rd traffic light take exit for Alexander Road. Proceed as above.*
