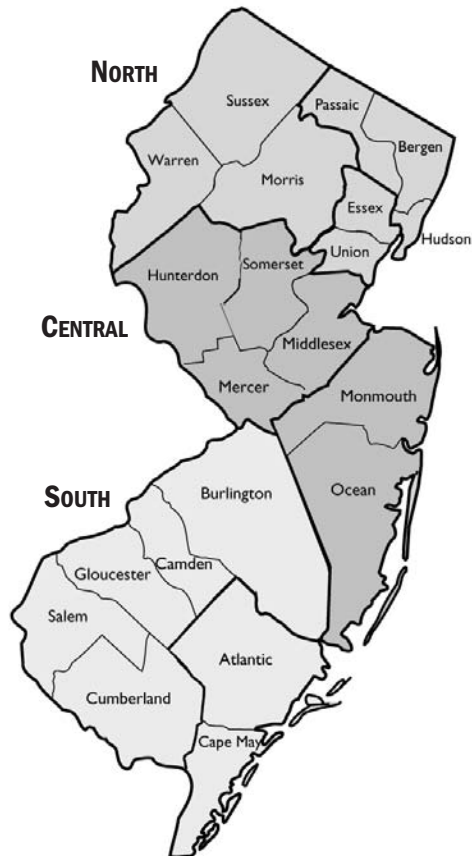


## REGIONS

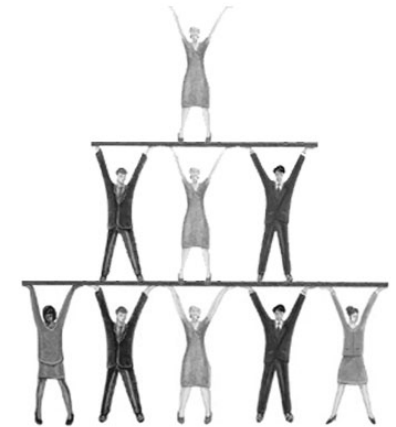
