SUBJECT: **Mandatory Nursing Home Compliance Programs Under the ACA**

The days of voluntary compliance programs for nursing homes are now over. Section 6102(b) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act provides the statutory text that requires a nursing home to have an effective compliance and ethics program in place by **March 23, 2013**. Thus, even though we are still waiting on regulations from CMS, it is necessary to be proactive with your program efforts to ensure compliance.
