The Partnership for Patients estimates that 30 percent of obstetrical adverse events are preventable. The goal set for hospitals is to cut the number of these events, preventing nearly 100,000 obstetric adverse events nationwide during the initiative's three years. To advance the successes of the Statewide Perinatal Safety Collaborative, the work of hospitals will continue as part of the national Partnership for Patients initiative and the New Jersey Hospital Engagement Network's attention to perinatal care.

- 7. Identify the mandates of recent New Jersey legislation regarding the provision of information on pertussis vaccine for adults at hospitals and birthing centers
- 8. Recognize New Jersey's role as a national leader in Critical Congenital Heart Defects screening
- 9. Share results of New Jersey's statewide CCHD screening mandate.
