## PROGRAM SUMMARY

The CCS Exam Preparation is a two-day refresher course designed to assist you with the challenges in studying for AHIMA's Certified Coding Specialist (CCS) Examination. Are you ready? Each program is designed to improve, review, refresh, and renew your coding skills.

Each program, the CPT Review and the ICD-9 Review, will assess test taking skills, offer guidance and practice with multiple choice test taking, and offer advice on what you need to do to prepare for the actual exam.

The methods utilized will include lecture, discussion, multiple choice tests, and exercises. We will target topics most likely to be covered in the CCS exam.

The CPT session on October 14 will cover CPT 101, conventions, the book, body systems, modifiers, reimbursement, and difficult coding topics including skin section, orthopedic sections, and scopes

The ICD-9-CM session on October 21 will cover guidelines, conventions, outpatient guidelines, the Present on Admission Indicator, and reimbursement issues. Topics will include coding of procedures, neoplasms, pregnancy, diabetes, infectious disease, and cardiac cases.

The CCS Exam Preparation is a two-day refresher course designed to help you pass the test. Participants may enroll one or both days. Participants are encouraged to bring their current CPT and ICD-9 books to the classes.

**From New York City and Northeastern New Jersey:** NJ Turnpike to Exit 8A. After toll follow sign to "Cranbury-South Brunswick." Use jughandle after 1st light to turn left onto 535. Go to 2nd light. Turn right onto 614 West (Dey Road). Continue several miles to the 3rd light. Turn right onto Scudders Mill Road. Follow signs and get onto Route 1 South. Continue to Alexander Road East/Princeton Junction exit. Take exit and turn right onto Alexander Road (Hyatt Regency Princeton is on your right). Go through 3 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

**From the Somerville area:** Route 206 South to Nassau Street (Rt. 27-Princeton). Turn left. Turn right at 1st traffic light onto University Place. At light turn left onto Alexander Road. Continue across Route 1. Go through 3 lights. The New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

**From Northwestern New Jersey:** Route 31 South to Route I-95 North. I-95 North becomes Route I-295 South. Continue to Exit 67A (New Brunswick) for U.S. Route 1 North, keeping left. After 3rd traffic light, take exit for Alexander Road. At top of ramp, at light, make right onto Alexander Road. Go through 2 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

**From Hightstown:** Route 571 West (approximately 6 miles). Turn left at traffic light between Exxon and Shell stations onto Alexander Road. Bear left. Take first right (Alexander Road) to cross over railroad tracks. Continue approximately 2 miles to New Jersey Hospital Association on left.

**From New Brunswick area:** U.S. Route 1 South (approximately 15 miles) to Alexander Road East/Princeton Junction exit. Take exit and turn right onto Alexander Road (Hyatt Regency Princeton is on your right). Go through 3 lights. New Jersey Hospital Association is on right. Park in rear of Building 760.

**From Philadelphia area:** I-95 North from Philadelphia, continue across the Delaware River into New Jersey. Continue to Exit 67A (New Brunswick) for Route 1 North. After 3rd traffic light take exit for Alexander Road.
