



## 2012 Benefit Rates for Unemployment Compensation, Temporary Disability, Family Leave and Workers' Compensation

Listed below are the 2011 and newly released 2012 maximum benefit amounts, taxable wages and earning requirements for New Jersey Unemployment Compensation, State Temporary Disability, Family Leave and Workers' Compensation Programs:

Minimum Amount to Qualify as a Base Week (UI, DI)	\$145	\$145
Alternative Earnings Requirement (UI, DI)	\$7,300	\$7,300
Taxable Wage Base (UI, DI, FLI)	\$29,600	\$30,300

To qualify for the 2012 maximum weekly benefit amount under the Unemployment Compensation Program, an individual must have gross weekly wages of \$1,018.

To qualify for the 2012 maximum weekly benefit amount under the State Plan Temporary Disability and Family Leave Program, an individual must have gross weekly wages of \$953.
