A recent study published in JAMA Internal Medicine projected nearly 15 percent of opioid-naïve patients hospitalized under Medicare are discharged with a new prescription for opioids, leading to as many as 1 in 4 individuals struggling with addiction ([www.cdc.gov/drugoverdose](http://www.cdc.gov/drugoverdose)). This complimentary webinar series hosted by NJHA/HRET will take a deep dive into how opioid misuse affects patients and healthcare workers from the perspective of numerous stakeholders, and will provide innovative tools to aid in the opioid misuse crisis.
