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AHA Issues Antimicrobial Stewardship Toolkit for Hospitals

Clinician Resources include Webinars, clinical evidence supporting appropriate use of antibiotics, implementation guides and related articles.

Patient Resources include frequently asked questions, pamphlets and handouts on how patients can best engage in their care and resources on appropriate use of antibiotics.
