Strategies for sepsis improvement was the topic of the New Jersey Sepsis Learning Action Collaborative's monthly webinar held on June 17. A general overview of various improvement models was quality followed by a focused presentation led by Jackie Blanchard, RN, MSN, CIC, Director of Infection Prevention for Atlantic Health System. Jackie outlined the journey that Newton Medical Center's sepsis team has taken over past three years as they participated in The Joint Commission's Center for Transforming Healthcare Reducing Sepsis Mortality project.

Medical Center's team followed the six sigma process of "Define Measure Analyze Improve Control (DMAIC)" a data driven quality strategy. As part of this process, Jackie and the sepsis team at Newton collected extensive baseline data, reviewed multiple sepsis related measures and controls, conducted root cause analysis and designed and tested solutions to improve sepsis outcomes. Following the presentation of the DMAIC process, Newton sepsis team members Dr. Anthony Brutico, Emergency Department Medical Director and Laura Anderson, RN, MSN, CIC, Manager of Infection Prevention discussed challenges and successes of implementing the various sepsis interventions, as well as a detailed sepsis case study.
