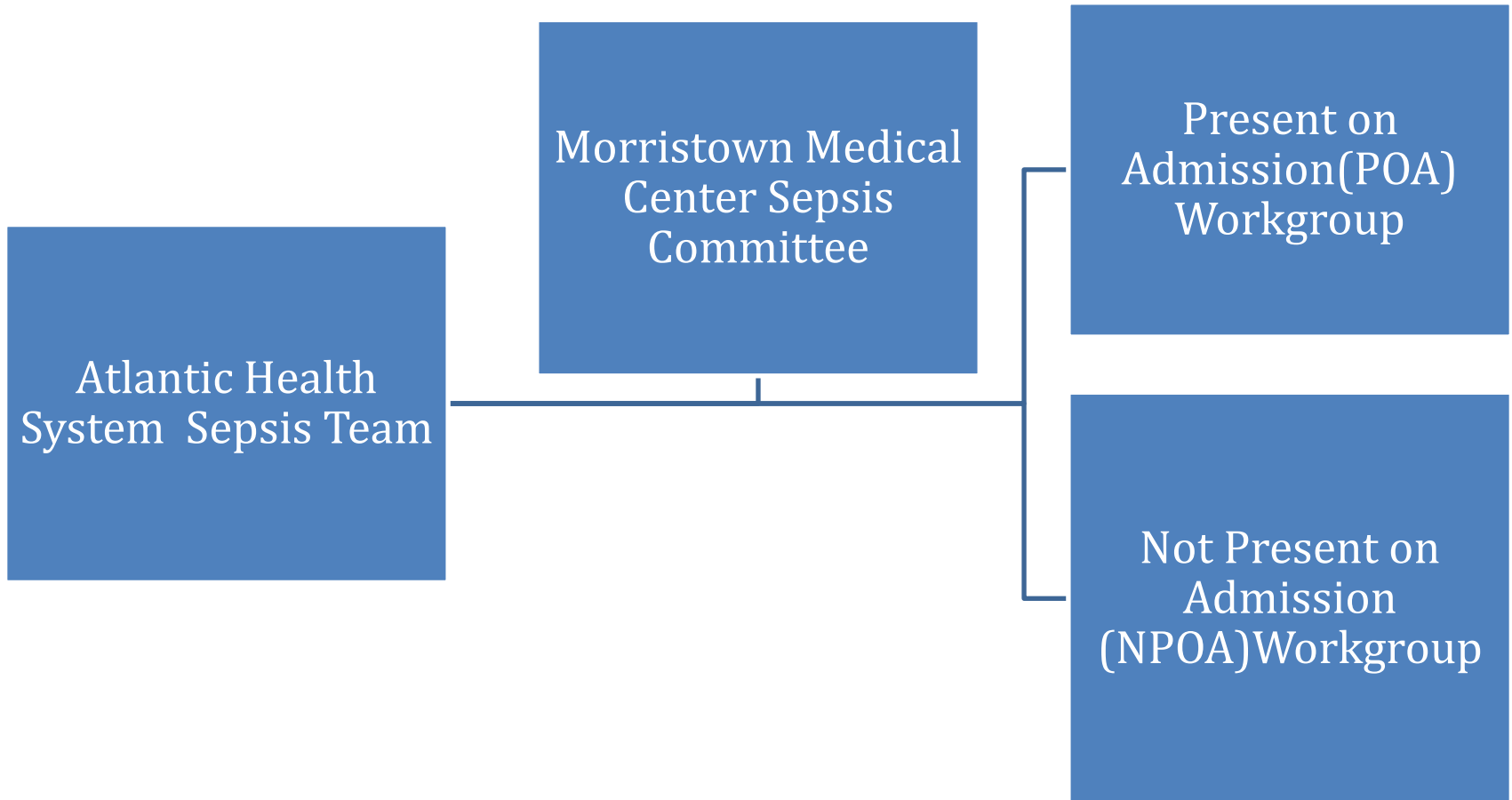

- Multidisciplinary-- includes physicians, nursing, pharmacy, lab, Information Technology, Medical Records, Quality Improvement, Infection Prevention
- To date has developed physician order sets, nursing alerts, practice algorithms, physician communication process, staff educational programs
- Created specific workgroups to address patient populations.

Present on Admission Workgroup (POA)

Priority :patients presenting through emergency room

- Current Issues
 - Triage and placement of patient
 - ED nurse protocol
 - IV access
 - Temperature methodology
 - Trigger criteria → Alert
 - Lactate Testing –point of care and repeats
 - Checklist and hand off communication
 - Staff education

Not Present on Admission Workgroup(NPOA)

Priority : Patients on any inpatient unit

- Current Issues

- Early Identification of patients

- Current Alerts and escalation process, trigger system

- Sepsis Order set

- Nurse as lead

- Lactate Testing –point of care vs lab drawn and repeat specimens
