WRK = Worker handling Ebola patient / TO = Trained Observer / HH = Hand Hygiene

1. Is the TO fully dressed and ready?
2. Is there a "contaminated seating area"?
3. Is there a "uncontaminated seating area"?
4. TO thoroughly inspects WRK for suit integrity. (2 meters)
5. TO applies HH to WRK outer gloves (HH after each step)
6. WRK sits removes shoes covers on chair reserved for such
7. HH operation on gloved hands
8. WRK removes outer gloves without touching exterior
9. TO inspects inner gloves for tears and then HH on gloved hands
10. WRK tilts head forward and removes face shield by grabbing rear strap
11. HH operation on gloved hands
12. WRK tilts head forward and removes hood by grabbing from rear
13. HH operation on gloved hands
14. Protective suit comes off without touching outside (roll & fold)
15. HH operation on gloved hands
16. WRK removes inner gloves without touching exterior
17. HH operation on bare hands
18. WRK puts new gloves
19. WRK tilts head forward the removes N95 respirator
20. HH operation on gloved hands
21. WRK sits on clean chair
22. WRK cleans shoes using disinfectant wipe
23. HH operation on gloved hands
24. WRK removes inner gloves
25. HH operation on bare hands
26. TO conducts final inspection for visual contamination
