

GFTTING THFRF

FLY: Chicago is served by two airports; O'Hare (ORD) and Midway (MDW).

- Cabs are available from both airports (approx. \$45 from O'Hare, \$32 from Midway).
- A train (the Blue Line) is available directly from O'Hare to downtown for \$5: Get off train at Washington and get on Red Line train. Get off Red Line train at Chicago Avenue (4-5 block walk to hotel).

TRAIN: Amtrak comes into Chicago's Union Station (just about 2 miles from the hotel). Cabs are available from Union Station.

DRIVE: Valet parking is available at the hotel at a rate of \$67/day. Self parking is available at multiple garages. Visit: http://chicago.bestparking.com/neighborhoods/streeterville-parking
