- The OPS Program launched in Spring of 2018 with 28 Instructors.
- Instructors received training from AWHONN staff on the proper methods to be used in teaching the program.

- The initial focus is on PPH, but the goal of the program will be to expand to include other topics.

OPS EDUCATION PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

GOALS

- Disseminate postpartum hemorrhage best practices to obstetric clinicians.
- Improve clinician's recognition of, readiness for, response to, and reporting of PPH.
- Providing greater access for women to receive early, effective, and aggressive lifesaving treatments for this obstetric emergency.



Objectives

- Discuss, review, and return demonstrate effective management for women who have excessive bleeding after giving birth.
- Use simulation-based cognitive, behavioral, and technical learning strategies to practice management of postpartum hemorrhage.

 - QBL/PPH stages, OPS Challenge, uterine tamponade balloon
- PPH simulation drill: 2.5 hours
