Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services released a comprehensive update to the long term care *State Operations Manual* which includes changes to significant investigative protocols: long term care providers must know the content of the changes, as well as understand how their facility policies and practices may need to be modified to maintain compliance. In addition, CMS also has announced that updates to the five star nursing home rating system will be made in 2015. These changes will mean that quality measures and reporting of staffing, as well as other parts of the system will be different. This program will focus on these changes and prepare long term care providers for how their data may change and how it will reflect their organization's operation.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To understand changes in regulations affecting facility practices, care delivery and care reporting;
- 2. To learn the most recent changes to surveillance programs including "worthless" services and false claims;
- 3. To prepare facilities to understand what their facility's data says about their organization.
