CAESARS HOTEL & CASINO ATLANTIC CITY

Caesars Hotel & Casino is located in central Atlantic City right on the boardwalk. The Atlantic City Expressway that connects Philadelphia ends a traffic light or two from the Caesars parking lot (self-parking on left). Valet parking is available one block closer to the boardwalk (on left at Caesars main entrance).



AIRPORTS

There are three airport options when traveling to Atlantic City: The Atlantic City Airport, the Philadelphia International Airport and Newark Liberty International (Newark, NJ). The Atlantic City Airport is small, but does run daily flights to and from various parts of the country. Philadelphia is about an hour and a half away and Newark is about 2 hours and 15 minutes away. Taxis to and from Philadelphia and Newark might be cost prohibitive.
