HEALTHY Beginnings NJ, Supporting Breastfeeding Moms & Babies, is a collaborative initiative aimed at increasing exclusive breastfeeding rates in New Jersey's maternity hospitals. - 2. Explains how one health system's inclusion vision has created an organizational culture for patients, families, physicians and employees that increases health equity and reduces disparities.
- 3. Understands how the intersection of race, class and culture influences disparities in breastfeeding rates.
- 4. Learns how collaborative models have resulted in successful community-based engagement efforts aimed at increasing exclusive breastfeeding rates.

Physicians. managers, nurses, quality, lactation consultants, heads of community health education, public health professionals and support staff.
