A hospital's compliance plan addresses the entities' compliance with fraud and abuse laws, as well as other federal and state regulatory laws applicable to health care organizations. This Webinar is designed to provide hospital trustees and administrators with an understanding of the Board of Trustees' role in the development and oversight of hospital compliance plans.

It will examine the fiduciary duties of care and loyalty as they arise under general corporate law and as they have been interpreted and applied in both the non-profit arena and healthcare specific sector. Specifically, this Webinar will provide hospitals' leaders with an understanding of the intersection of trustees' obligation to exercise a duty of care and the ongoing oversight of a healthcare entities' compliance program.

This Webinar also will address general obligations of trustees applicable to all non-profit boards, as well as those obligations specific to trustees serving on the board of a hospital that arise based on the heightened scrutiny applied to healthcare entities. It will examine some of the seminal case law in order to answer what are considered to be questions foremost in a trustee's mind: what is the Board of Trustees' obligation to oversee an entity's compliance plan and to what extent can a trustee be held personally liable for a breakdown in such a plan?
