PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The NJHA Government Relations and Policy department is hosting Healthcare Advocacy 101, a skills building and hands-on lobbying training course for clinical professionals. - 4. Describes the regulatory process in New Jersey and illustrates the means to shape state regulation
- 5. Identifies the role of the Health Care Administration Board in developing healthcare related regulation.
