OVERVIEW:

This program will address critical safety issues for patients in the intensive care unit. The speakers will discuss a range of topics that are relevant to improving care processes for patients as well as engagement of families.

In the spirit of the Partnership for Patients “learning-action” theme, we will be including two storyboard presentation sessions during this conference. All healthcare organizations that are represented as participants are asked to prepare a storyboard that illustrates an example of how they have improved patient safety or quality of care within their own critical care setting. Examples can include (but not limited to): reducing device related infections (CAUTI, CLABSI, or VAE), early mobility programs, spontaneous awaking and breathing trials, pain and sedation management, delirium assessment and prevention, etc.

Elements to be addressed in the storyboard:

- Introduction to your site and quality improvement project
- Changes that were tested as part of the improvement
- Result of the changes
- Challenges you faced
- Success that you achieved
- Next steps

Storyboards can be displayed as no more than six PowerPoint slides or a poster. The day of the learning session, teams should bring their printed slides/poster to NJHA.

When you arrive the morning of the learning session, you will receive information indicating which time and table location your storyboard should be posted. Teams will be assigned to present during one of two 45-minute storyboard sessions. These sessions will be held in a gallery format with teams rotating through and viewing individual storyboards.

One team member should be stationed at the storyboard to present the slides to participants during the designated session.

OBJECTIVES:

1. State the importance of including family engagement in the critical care setting
2. List essential interventions to prevent ventilator associated events
3. Identify key tools and processes to assess, manage and treat pain, agitation and delirium of critically ill patients.
4. Identify resources that can be used to help promote early mobility of critically ill patients.
