OVERVIEW:

Improving the use of antibiotics is an important patient safety and public health issue as well as a national priority. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, a growing body of evidence demonstrates that hospital based programs dedicated to improving antibiotic use, commonly referred to as Antibiotic Stewardship Programs (ASPs), can both optimize the treatment of infections and reduce adverse events associated with antibiotic use.

This program will demonstrate the need for healthcare organizations across the continuum of care to implement antimicrobial stewardship programs and how to tie those efforts to other patient safety issues including management and prevention of *Clostridium difficile*.
