OVERVIEW:

The mission of the New Jersey Sepsis Learning-Action Collaborative and this face-to-face program is to spread evidence-based sepsis interventions throughout the acute and post-acute care settings. In this second year of the collaborative, hospitals face challenges related to managing sepsis in vulnerable patient populations and improving compliance with national sepsis quality reporting requirements and clinical definition changes. This program will focus on dealing with those challenges and building on past successes to sustain the improvement efforts aimed at early recognition and rapid treatment of sepsis.

Important: All hospitals and post-acute facilities attending are expected to design and present a sepsis storyboard during the meeting. The topic of the storyboard is “Strategies to Meet the CMS SEP-1 Measure.” Teams should describe:

- A strategy that has worked to improve CMS SEP-1 bundle compliance
- The biggest challenge to implementing the CMS SEP-1 measure
- Improvements still needed and how to get there.

Storyboards can be displayed as no more than six PowerPoint slides on a poster. Teams should bring their team’s poster to NJHA the day of the session.

Upon arrival, teams will receive information indicating table location for the storyboard and will be assigned a presentation time during one of two 45-minute storyboard sessions. These sessions will be held in a gallery format with teams rotating through and viewing individual storyboards.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Discuss the current state of severe sepsis collaborative activities and impact of CMS sepsis measures in New Jersey
2. Understand the newly-released *Third International Consensus Definitions for Sepsis and Sepsis Shock* and the impact on hospital sepsis programs
3. Recognize challenges with identifying and treating sepsis in elderly patients
4. Discuss the risks factors related to sepsis readmissions and preventative strategies
5. Discuss relevant issues and challenges that hospitals are facing in the sepsis improvement efforts.
