Overview:

Healthcare professionals in all settings – clinical practice, academia and management – have exciting ideas and innovations that would be beneficial to share with others. However, many are not familiar with the writing and publishing process and thus sharing through professional literature, a traditional communication channel, can be a daunting task. In this workshop, Dr. Leslie Nicoll will use "Manuscript Success" as a method to demystify the publishing process and provide practical evidence-based strategies for achieving publication goals. Using presentation, audience participation, questions and discussion, participants will gain knowledge and confidence in how to write manuscripts that will be favorably received by editors and reviewers. Identifying and overcoming pitfalls, ethical issues and effective use of resources will also be discussed.

Learner Outcome:

After successfully completing the course, the learner will identify at least two evidence-based strategies for achieving publication goals.*

Topics will include:

- 1. Five steps in the Manuscript Success process
- 2. Journal due diligence
- 3. Description of subscription-based, open access, and predatory journals
- 4. Different types of plagiarism that may occur in scholarly writing
- 5. Ethical issue related to authorship
- 6. Create a realistic timeline for developing a scholarly portfolio.
