### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

hat behaviors strengthen nursing practice? Learn how the interactions of leaders and colleagues impact both our job satisfaction and patient outcomes. Susan Scott, PhD., RN, shares insights on her research related to second victim. Attendees will understand the Second Victim Phenomenon, how to avoid it and how to support her experience of cultivating an area of interest and creating a program of research.

Research related to workplace environment, unique educational strategies for engaging students or clinical nurses, as well as selecting the correct instrument to measure outcomes will be included in this full-day program. During the poster sessions, attendees will have the opportunity to network with seasoned and novice researchers as they discuss issues impacting nurses in New Jersey and across the Country.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Review research that highlights the impact of the Second Victim Phenomenon, on both an individual as well as to the nursing profession.
- Understand the path of building on prior research to develop expertise.
- Be able to apply skills learned related to new strategies of education and/or selecting an appropriate research instrument and,
- Be able to compare research findings related to workplace environment to existing conditions and discuss opportunities for change.

### **LEARNER OUTCOME**

After successfully completing the course, the learner will identify the "second-victim" phenomenon and high-risk clinical events.

Successful completion of the course is defined as in-person attendance for 95% of the didactic learning session and a completed course evaluation.
