**PreManage ED:**

NJHA and the Health Research and Educational Trust of New Jersey are excited to present an opportunity to our members to help confront opioid abuse in our state. We have recently finalized an agreement to bring Collective Medical Technologies' PreManage ED system to our members. HRET is funding the first-year costs for members to bring this tool to their emergency departments.

PreManage ED, also known as EDIE, is an ED-based collaborative care management tool designed to simplify and streamline access to patient information in the ED. It's designed to integrate with existing clinical workflows and data sources, so the actionable patient insights are pushed to ED providers when a high-risk patient presents.

The NJHA and HRET Boards voted to bring this product to our members. We are able to extend this opportunity to our members without an impact on dues or our budget by dedicating a portion of HRET's excess reserves to a public good.

Collective Medical Technologies has sold this product to state associations and hospitals in several other states including Massachusetts, Washington, Oregon and New Hampshire. NJHA staff, along with members of the New Jersey Chapter of American College of Emergency Physicians, saw the tool in action in site visits to some hospitals already using it. NJHA's IT team also has reviewed the technical aspects of connectivity and integrating PreManage ED with information from the New Jersey Prescription Monitoring program.
