## **OVERVIEW:**

In the healthcare setting, ALL employees may come into contact with a human trafficking victim seeking medical treatment. Having a Human Trafficking Response Program in place usually leads to the victim being identified and rescued. Having this program also fosters a collaborative relationship among law enforcement agencies, victim service providers and the community.

This course will introduce learners to the crime of human trafficking as defined by New Jersey laws and in the United States Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 (TVPA). The historical context of the trafficking of human beings in the United States will be discussed, as well as the legal and investigative elements of these crimes. Prosecutions of human traffickers will be examined to teach learners how human traffickers operate. Learners will also learn how to identify human trafficking victims in a healthcare setting, and what actions should be taken when trafficking is suspected.
