Beginning October 1, 2019, Skilled Nursing Facilities will implement the most significant change in Medicare Part A payments in decades with the Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM).

With PDPM, the focus will shift from volume of services to resident need with verifiable patient-specific characteristics, treatments, and ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes will drive the SNF payment.
