The 2022 ICD-10-CM and PCS updates are effective with discharges on and after October 1, 2021. Will you be ready?

The ICD-10-CM code set for 2022 includes 159 additions, 30 deletions, and 22 revised codes.

The ICD-10-PCS code set for 2022 includes 191 new codes; 62 revision titles; and 187 deleted codes.

Diseases of the: Nervous System; Circulatory System; Skin and Subcutaneous Tissue; Musculoskeletal System; Conditions Originating in the Perinatal Period; Symptoms, Signs, and Abnormal Findings; Injuries, Poisoning, and Certain Consequences of External Causes; External Cause of Morbidity; Factors Influencing Health Status and Contact with Health Service and Codes for Special Purposes.
