Visitation Guidance

RED LEVEL GUIDANCE No Visitors, with limited exceptions All exceptions MUST be approved by care team

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT	<p>EXCEPTION: one parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay</p> <p>EXCEPTION: Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns.</p>
OBSTETRICS/L&D	<p>EXCEPTION: one visitor, must be the same person, for duration of birth parent's stay</p> <p>EXCEPTION: one doula, must be the same doula, for duration of birth parent's stay</p>
SURGERY/PROCEDURE PATIENTS	<p>EXCEPTION: provided social distancing can be accomplished, one visitor until patient is taken into prep</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visitor must then leave - Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns.
ADULT IN-PATIENT	<p>EXCEPTION: one visitor, must be the same person, for patients in hospital more than 72 hours</p> <p>EXCEPTION: one visitor at discharge for bedside discharge directions and education</p>
PEDIATRICS	<p>EXCEPTION: same two parents or guardians may visit at the same time, unless COVID+ and PUI guideline applies</p> <p>EXCEPTION: siblings may be permitted for end of life</p>
PSYCHIATRY	<p>EXCEPTION: Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns.</p> <p>Permission to visit is granted at discretion of care team, including time and duration of visit</p> <p>Permission to visit must be approved by care team in advance of visit</p>
IMMUNOCOMPROMISED	<p>EXCEPTION: one parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay</p> <p>EXCEPTION: one visitor at a time for patients receiving end of life care</p> <p>EXCEPTION: one visitor, must be the same person, for patients in labor</p> <p>EXCEPTION: Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns.</p>
END OF LIFE	<p>EXCEPTION: up to two visitors at same time, and visitors may switch throughout the day</p>



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YELLOW LEVEL GUIDANCE	Hospital Visits are limited
EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT	One visitor, must be same person, for duration of stay
OBSTETRICS/L&D	<p>One visitor at a time for duration of birth parent's stay</p> <p>One doula, must be the same doula, for duration of birth parent's stay</p>
SURGERY/PROCEDURE PATIENTS	<p>Provided social distancing can be accomplished, one visitor until patient is taken into prep</p> <p>One visitor when patient is in recovery and preparing for discharge</p>
ADULT IN-PATIENT	<p>One visitor at a time</p> <p>Visitors may change but cannot overlap</p>
PEDIATRICS	<p>Two parents or guardians may visit at the same time, unless COVID+ and PUI guideline applies</p> <p>Siblings may be permitted for end of life</p>
IMMUNOCOMPROMISED	<p>No Visitors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - EXCEPTION: one parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay - EXCEPTION: Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns. - EXCEPTION: one visitor, must be same person, for patients receiving end of life care
PSYCHIATRY	<p>One visitor, must be same person for duration, may be permitted</p> <p>Permission to visit is granted at discretion of care team, including time and duration of visit</p> <p>Permission to visit must be approved by care team in advance of visit</p>
END OF LIFE	<p>Up to two visitors may visit at the same time</p> <p>Visitors may switch throughout the day</p>



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GREEN LEVEL GUIDANCE	Visitors permitted with some limits
EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT	Up to two visitors permitted for duration
OBSTETRICS/L&D	Up to two visitors permitted at same time One doula, must be the same doula, for duration of birth parent's stay
SURGERY/PROCEDURE PATIENTS	Provided social distancing can be accomplished, one visitor until patient is taken into prep One visitor when patient is in recovery and preparing for discharge
ADULT IN-PATIENT	Up to two visitors permitted at same time
PEDIATRICS	Two parents or guardians may visit at the same time, unless COVID+ and PUI guideline applies Siblings may be permitted for end of life
IMMUNOCOMPROMISED	<p>No Visitors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - EXCEPTION: one parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay - EXCEPTION: Exceptions may apply to pediatrics, labor and delivery, end of life, and patients with intellectual, developmental or cognitive impairment including dementia, communication barriers or behavioral concerns. - EXCEPTION: one visitor, must be same person, for patients receiving end of life care
PSYCHIATRY	One visitor, must be same person for duration, may be permitted Permission to visit is granted at discretion of care team Permission to visit must be approved by care team in advance of visit
END OF LIFE	No limit on number of visitors permitted, provided care team approves and deems it is safe and feasible to meet social distancing guidelines
