*The Train-the-Trainer series is designed to offer long term care facilities the opportunity to have staff trained as infection prevention leaders and trainers. Each session will focus on a different infection prevention topic. Participants will be provided the curriculum, slide decks, checklists, competency tests, handouts, and other resources needed to deliver the infection prevention education. During the live, web-based instructor training, participants will learn techniques and best practices for training others, such as utilizing role play and other methodology. Participants are expected to develop a plan for coordinating and offering a minimum of five training sessions for their facility/organization by June 2024. Delivery of continuing education credits will be contingent upon submission of a written plan.
